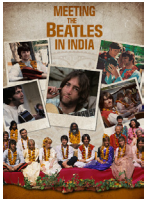


At The Movies

In 1968, at the height of their fame, the Beatles traveled to India to study transcendental meditation with Maharishi Mahesh Yogi, resulting in one of their most prolific creative periods when they wrote 48 songs in about 48 days. This serene documentary weaves together archival material and provides previously undisclosed observations and insight from insiders and experts that pull back the curtain on that mysterious and transformational spiritual trip. Notable appearances in the film include film director David Lynch, Pattie Boyd, Beatles historian Mark Lewisohn, film composer Laurence Rosenthal, maestro Hariprasad Chaurasia and the real Bungalow Bill.
